Only licensed competitors are eligible to participate in the official competition.

Competitors who are licensed, but do not belong to a club, must bring a certificate of medical examination that is not older than 6 months.

Competition rules

Lead:

Categories D6, D8 and D10 (U8, U10 and U12) climb qualifications “flash”, two routes, top rope, in the event of the same result for the first place after the qualifying round, a superfinal will be organized.

Kadets (U14) and Juniors B climb qualifications “flash”, two routes and finals “on sight”, one final route, lead climbing. In the finals, the 4 best placed from the category from the qualifying round pass. Two final groups of 8 female and 8 male finalists. In case of same result in the finals, the better competitor is the one who had a higher rank in qualifying round. If the result from qualifying round is also the same, competitors share the placement, unless it's first place, in which case a superfinal is organized.

Juniors A, Juniors and Seniors categories formed into one group, climb qualifications “flash”, two routes and finals “on sight”, one final route, lead climbing, in the finals the 8 best placed from the qualifying round pass. In case of same result in the finals, the better competitor is the one who had a higher rank in qualifying round. If the result from qualifying round is also the same, competitors share the placement, unless it's first place, in which case a superfinal is organized.

Tentative program of the competition

Depending on the number of registered competitors, as well as other circumstances, it is possible to change the schedule, about which the representatives of the clubs will be informed in a timely manner.

After the end of the competition for each group category, the winners will be announced and medals will be awarded for the categories belonging to that group.
